The accreditation programmes provide formal recognition of the integrity and competence of certification bodies. These certification bodies are also able to benchmark their practices against that of other certification bodies.

International acceptance

As a member of the Multilateral Recognition Arrangement (MLA) for Quality Management

System of both the Pacific Accreditation Cooperation (PAC) and the International Accreditation Forum (IAF), certificates issued by SAC accredited certification bodies are recognised worldwide by MLA members across more than 50 economies

Accreditation criteria

Certification bodies must meet specific international or national standards, and SAC requirements in order to be accredited. The accreditation criteria are as follows:

- ISO/IEC 17021 Conformity Assessment -Requirements for Bodies Providing Audit and Certification of Management Systems
- ISO/TS 22003 Food Safety Management Systems – Requirements for Bodies Providing Audit and Certification of Food Safety Management Systems
- Applicable IAF Mandatory Documents
- Applicable SAC CT Documents

The certification bodies will be assessed based on their independence, integrity and technical competence. Management system certification bodies must demonstrate their ability to audit the organisations' management systems against the requirements of international and national standards such as ISO 9001, ISO 14001, ISO 22000, SS 506: Part 1 and/or Part 3 and etc.
